Nukkad Natak are a very effective way to put across message in an interesting manner, leaving an unforgettable impression on the minds of the audiences.

Law centre-I is celebrating its Golden Jubilee year and to make the celebration more vibrant, the Centre is organizing “**UDGHOSH, The National Nukkad Natak Competition**” for which teams from law schools are cordially invited to participate. There is no registration fee. The participants have to make their own lodging and boarding arrangements.

The theme of the Competition is,

“From Pink and Blue to a Rainbow World: A Semi-Centenary Celebration of Gender Struggle”

As we all know the Indian Society has witnessed a total transformation in its social structure in last 50 years. The theme indicates the struggles undertaken by persons of different genders in order to not only survive but to live with dignity. Today, we live in a society where men, women and LGBTQs have to co-exist, are to be respected and acknowledged. All the genders have fought their own battles and have overcome their vulnerabilities to an extent and that is how we all learn to evolve and get strength to fight till we make the world a better place for all of us to live with all fairness.

One team from one law school is invited to join us in this celebration through Nukkad Nataks. The Registration Form should be countersigned by the HOD of the institution.

The Theme, Rules, Registration Form and other important information is given below:

Theme:

“From Pink and Blue to a Rainbow World: A Semi-Centenary Celebration of Gender Struggle”

Sub themes:

- Gender stereotype
- Domestic violence
- Female foeticide
- Dowry

- Sexual Abuse
 - Children
 - Female
 - Male
- Gender vs. Sex
- Sexual harassment
- Acid attacks, etc.

The list of sub-themes is not exhaustive and the participants may choose any other issue that bears relevance to the theme.

RULES:

1. Each team must have minimum 8 and maximum 12 participants.
2. All the participants must be from the same institute, although students from different years are allowed to form a team.
3. There will be one round in which each team will have to perform for 10 minutes. Use of extra time will lead to deduction of marks.
4. Any kind of obscenity reported during the performance will lead to immediate disqualification of the team.
5. Any electronic device or music recording is not allowed.
6. Teams have to bring their own costumes and props etc. which they intend to use during their performance.
7. Play should be bilingual in Hindi and English which is used during general course of day to day conversations.
8. Pre-registration is mandatory for all the teams. The last date for registration is 26th February, 2020.

10. Alongwith the registration, the team is required to submit the following by WhatsApp to 9868012202 for final selection:
 - a. Synopsis of the nukkad natak / Script
 - b. Short clip of 2-3 minutes of the nukkad natak
11. The clip should not disclose the name of the institution. The synopsis / script should have **a separate page** indicating the name of team leader / contact person, number of participants, year and course of study, name of institution. This page should be duly signed by the Head / Principal / Incharge of the institution.
